We have exciting news. Our chromebooks are arriving! NPS staff will begin assigning and handing out chromebooks on Tuesday, October 10th to students who have signed the NPS Chromebook agreement.

To help save paper the NPS Chromebook Agreement is online under Parents/Students then Forms. Both you as a parent and your child will need to sign the document. A summation of the document is below. If you have any questions please reach out to Mr. Coors.

- 1. The goal of the NPS 1:1 Chromebook program is to....
 - a. Use technology to supplement learning in the classroom
 - b. Efficiently find information and create projects that demonstrate learning
 - c. Speed up the feedback loop between teacher to student and student to student
 - d. Learn how to use technology responsibility
- 2. Use of CPS internet
 - a. There is great power and responsibility when using the internet. Students should ask a staff member if they are unsure about using a particular website.
 - b. We utilize a web browser watch system called GoGuardian. Teachers and Admin will be able to see any website that is visited by students using the CPS network.
 - c. Students are expected to only visit websites for learning and classroom assignments.
 - d. If a student continually visits inappropriate websites their CPS network privileges will be revoked for a time determined by the administration.
- 3. Responsibility for Chromebook
 - a. We must all care for our new materials so they last for years to come. Chromebooks will stay on school grounds and be locked in a secure location at the end of each day.
 - b. Parents and students are responsible for any damage outside of normal wear and tear.
 - c. A fee schedule is listed here for reference
